

Immigrants and the COVID Vaccine: What Do I Need to Know?

Updated January 25, 2021



The COVID vaccine should be *free for most people*. This includes people without health insurance. People who do have insurance should bring that information with them.



Immigrants *can* get the COVID vaccine. No immigration status or social security number is necessary. You may be asked for your social security number, but you are not required to provide it.

No ID is required to get the COVID vaccine.*



Your information is kept *confidential*. Vaccine providers may not share any personal information about you with ICE for immigration enforcement.



Getting the COVID vaccine does not have *any negative impact* on your chances of getting a green card.

The COVID vaccine is *safe and effective*.
