Gov. Snyder names ACCESS Executive Director Hassan Jaber to state commission

Dearborn, Mich. – Gov. Rick Snyder announced Dec. 18 the appointment of ACCESS Executive Director Hassan Jaber, of Dearborn, and three others to the State Officers Compensation Commission.

"These individuals have strong leadership backgrounds. I am confident they will do great work and bring valuable insights to the commission," Snyder said in a news release.

The SOCC is a seven-person board responsible for determining the salaries and expense allowances of the attorney general, secretary of state, justices of the Michigan Supreme Court, members of the Legislature, lieutenant governor and governor.

Jaber was chosen because of his dedication to the community. He serves on the boards of United Way for Southeastern Michigan, the Detroit Zoological Society, CultureSource and Henry Ford Health System and serves on the University of Michigan-Dearborn Citizens Advisory Committee and the U.S. Census National Advisory Committee.

Jaber and the other appointees will serve four-year terms until Jan. 1, 2018.
